Palmer River/Maytown -

30th April and 1st, 2nd, 3rd, May 2010

Anticipated Trip Grade: **3/4**

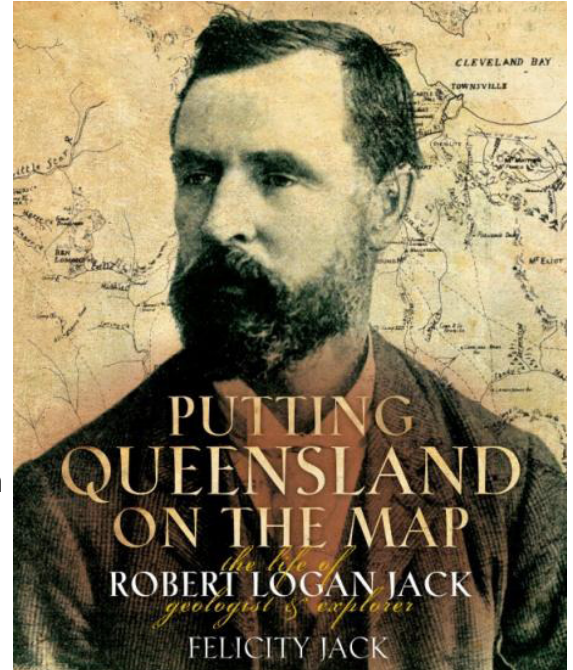
Low range and high ground clearance. Mud/All terrain tyres. Appropriate recovery equipment and experience required.

Date – **30th April and 1st, 2nd, 3rd, May 2010**

Departure – **Caravonica State School**

at 6.30am for 7.00am departure



Friday 30th

Justin will take us via Mount Carbine (last fuel stop) to the McLeod River for morning tea before driving on the Peninsula Development Road to Laura where we will camp for the first night.

Saturday 1st

We will travel to the South Palmer River via the Logan Jack Memorial. You will be in low range/diff lock all day with steep grades and creek crossings. The 43km should take us about 8 hours. The second night will be spent at South Palmer River, good camping and good swimming.

Sunday 2nd

Explore historical sites at Maytown, fishing, walking, relaxing etc.

Monday 3rd

Wake up, have breakfast, pack up and leave for home. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way out there is a dam where we will stop for a quick snack. We will return home via Mount Carbine for lunch at around 2.00pm

Notes:-

Crocodiles in Adams Dam and Palmer River. Take lots of drinking water, food and all necessary camping equipment. You'll need fuel for some 550-600 kilometres.

Because of the rocky nature of the tracks it is important that your tyres (including spare) are in good condition. The trip leader can refuse you participating in the trip if your vehicle is not in good mechanical condition.
